<u>Notation</u>

٥

- **Breathy**; but with clearly defined pitch
- Every Breathy; more breath than tone
- **Breath only**; with no pitch
- - **= Whistle Tone**; Whistle tones shouldn't be precise, but should follow the general contour of the line for the duration of the notation.
 - = **Tongue Air Attack**; when present, a dotted line indicates the approximate placement of air attacks within the bracket.

 The number of attacks are noted above the boxed graphic and should be played with no specified rhythm.
 - **= Highest Note Possible;** within the parameters of the duration, strive for the highest note possible.

Breathing

= Exhaling

fig. = Inhaling

[a] [e] [i] [o] [u] = IPA Symbols; these are used in combination with breath notation to shape the inhale and exhale of air. When breath notation is present without IPA symbol, it should be assumed to use [a].

- = Open Mouth Embouchure; lip is away from the lip plate.
- = Tone Producing embouchure; lip rests on lip plate of flute.
- = Cover Tone Hole; only cover the tone hole of the lip plate.
- = Cover Lip Plate; lips should cover entire lip plate.

Arrows and Lines

--- gradual transition; a smooth transition between markings.

continuation; previous marking/notation should be continued for the duration of the line.

Sizzle; in combination with breath, the effect is that of a "hiss" sound.
